**Current Conditions**

It appears that the Mississippi River at Aitkin crested Thursday (June 28<sup>th</sup>) at 18.71 feet. The gage reading at 7:00 a.m. this morning was at 17.87 feet. That is down about ten (10) inches..

Severe flooding continues for Big Sandy Lake. The crest on June 28<sup>th</sup> was at 1222.93 feet. According to the most recent river gage reading, at 10:00 p.m. last night, the level was at 1222.38 feet. It had fallen about six and one-half (6.5) inches since the crest.

Last night the county realized, according to reports, between one-half (1/2) and four (4) inches of rain. No word yet on the impact that the overnight rainfall will have on the flood status of either the Mississippi River at Aitkin or Big Sandy Lake.

The seven day forecast calls for chances of rain each of the next five days.

More sandbags are being transported to the Shamrock Township hall this morning.

Informational meetings have been held at Aitkin, Big Sandy and Hill City. More are being planned for both Grace Lutheran Church (Big Sandy) and the snowmobile club meeting in Hill City. Drop in centers are also established at those two sites so that emergency supplies (food, water and cleaning supplies) are available to residents in need. Those supplies are also available at the Aitkin County Sheriff's Office.

Aitkin County Sheriff's Office, with assistance of MN DNR enforcement and Anoka County Sheriff's Office maintaining a 24 hour presence on Big Sandy Lake. Increased patrol on other lakes that have had more flood-related impact.

Educations efforts being coordinated by Aitkin County Public Health focusing on the flood related issues. (safe water, cleanup, etc.)

Aitkin County MIS posting much needed information to Aitkin County website.

Aitkin County Road and Bridge keeping road closures consistently updated.

Debris management an emerging issue that will need to be more completely addressed.

To Whom it may concern:

We are writing this letter in support of Mrs. Sue Andersen and her beloved dog of ten years, Moby. We are truly unable to convey our dismay over the situation that has occurred with Moby. This is atypical for this breed, as they are dogs that are known to love children. Moby has demonstrated his affection for children during his life with Mrs. Andersen.

Unfortunately, because there wasn't an adult present at the time of the accident, we can only offer an anecdotal possibility of what may have occurred. Dogs react to pain in a far different manner than humans do. If a dog is injured, hurt, or startled, a typical response would be to "snap." Ask any animal control officer what's the first thing they do in dealing with an injured or hurt animal; they will tell you that they control the dog's ability to "snap" or "bite." Under the circumstances that we described above, a similar response could never be construed as the dog being "dangerous," but rather as a singular response to an acute situation.

We tell new puppy owners, based on our experience, that these dogs are "magnets" for children. Frequently they will run to the dog, sometimes poking or grasping or startling the dog. A ten year old dog generally has arthritic joints which would make a simple bump or shove painful. Of course, all we know about what happened in this situation is the result; not the circumstances that set the event in motion.

We believe that historical data shows that when an aggressive animal attacks a child or adult it would inflict multiple bites rather than one localized injury. Frequently when there is a puncture of the skin the normal reaction is to pull away which would cause a tear, similar to that the child had repaired. We understand that there was no puncture from the opposing teeth which you would see if the dog bit to grip the child.

Because there was not a witness to this incident, one can't conclude with any certainty, the circumstances, or actions that could have precipitated this event. In this instance, we believe that all reasonable individuals would then, necessarily, have to rely on the known, demonstrated history of the dog; his interactions with people, and specifically, children, to form a reasonable, thoughtful conclusion.

Everything that we know about this breed in our 25 years of breeding, showing in conformation, obedience, agility and training certified Therapy Dogs, tells us that if Moby had a propensity to bite, this wouldn't have been the first time. Considering his age, he has certainly had many opportunities to demonstrate his true temperament to individuals that he has interacted with. While we don't want to minimize the result of any bite, we also don't believe that a "dangerous" dog designation is warranted based on this singular incident. Moby clearly has a history of being a friendly, outgoing and social dog.

Moby has been a loved family member of the Anderson household for ten years. He has never exhibited aggressive or fear biting behavior. He has been friendly and social with people he has met. It was an accident that Moby found himself in a situation where he was exposed to a young child without adult supervision which resulted in an injury. We ask that rather than labeling him a "dangerous" dog and potentially ending his life, you allow Mrs. Andersen to make the changes to the environmental factors that allowed this situation to take place and thereby prevent any possible recurrence.

Is there a plan to review the no-wake restriction on the lakes in the Southern part of the county? Water levels on Clear, Sugar, Rabbit and other lakes in the Glen area are not only manageable, but not appreciably higher than they have been in recent years. Lakes just to the West in Crow Wing County, such as Bay Lake, have had the same amount of rain yet they remain open for boaters to enjoy the water during this, the busiest vacation time of the year.

The purpose of the no-wake restriction on those lakes where there is flooding is understood and appreciated by all, but it would seem reasonable of the county to consider the water levels on all lakes before making such wide-sweeping restrictions.

**WHEREAS**, Aitkin County has declared a major disaster and approved resolution 062612-064 requesting a Presidential Disaster Declaration, and

**WHEREAS**, this disaster requires the County Board to provide for services which result in expenditures that were unexpected in the 2012 Budget, and

**WHEREAS**, senior staff have discussed the need to "move quickly" to address immediate needs in the County related to the disaster, and

**WHEREAS**, the County Board realize that some issues like debris removal and septic tank related issues arise between County Board meetings and that staff need to react quickly.
