### No New Right-of-Way or Pipeline Construction Required

MN-PUC Docket No. PL9/CN-12-590

Dear Elected Official/Community/Tribal Leader:

Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership ("Enbridge") is proposing to expand the capacity of its Line 67 Pipeline as part of its ongoing efforts to meet North America's needs for reliable and secure transportation of petroleum energy supplies.

The project, known as the Line 67 Station Upgrade Project ("Project"), would increase the annual average capacity of Line 67 from 450,000 barrels per day ("bpd")<sup>1</sup> to 570,000 bpd, providing Enbridge with the ability to deliver an incremental 120,000 barrels per day of secure and reliable crude oil supplies to refineries and numerous marketing hubs throughout the Midwest and beyond. Those refineries, in turn, supply transportation fuels, heating oil, asphalt, jet fuel, petrochemicals and petrochemical feed stocks needed in our homes, industry, and transportation. The Project involves the installation of new pumping units, including all valves and appurtenances, and other minor station modification work at Enbridge's Viking, Clearbrook and Deer River Pump Station sites, which are located in Marshall, Clearwater and Itasca Counties, Minnesota. The Project will not require the acquisition of new land or require pipeline construction outside the pump stations. All work will be performed within the footprint of Enbridge's pump stations. A Project Overview Map is provided as Attachment 1a.

Pending regulatory approval by the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission ("MPUC"), the Project would be in-service by July 1, 2014. The additional capacity will help relieve capacity constraints on Enbridge's Mainline System and provide refineries access to crude oil

Line 67 Station Upgrade Project supplies from western Canada, Montana and North Dakota, as supplies from these prolific production areas are continuing to rise.

You are receiving this letter because you are an elected official, tribal government official, government agency representative, or community leader who has jurisdiction within the notice area. The notice area is defined as property traversed by Line 67 and "abutting property" which is located immediately adjacent to Enbridge's pumping station sites where Project work will be performed but that is not traversed by Line 67. Please see the following attached overview map which depicts the Line 67 stations receiving upgrades.

The purpose of this letter is to notify you of Enbridge's Project plans and provide details on how you can participate in the MPUC's regulatory review process. A similar notice is being mailed to landowners whose property is crossed by Line 67 and abutting property owners and residents located immediately adjacent to Enbridge's pumping stations area where Project work will be performed.

Enbridge has filed a certificate of need application with the MPUC for review and approval. To view a copy of the application, visit the MPUC's website at <a href="www.puc.state.mn.us">www.puc.state.mn.us</a>, choose the "Search E-Dockets" link, select "12" from the first Docket Number dropdown box and enter "590" in the second box. The MPUC must certify that the Project is needed before Enbridge can construct the Project. The application process is governed by Minnesota Law, including Chapter 7853 of the Minnesota Rules and Chapter 216B of the Minnesota Statutes.



### Dear County and MnDNR officials:

We are very, very concerned about the lake level of Round Lake located in Waukenabo Township. Of particular concern is the appearance that someone is tampering with the outlet to the lake, making the lake level the lowest it has been in years. It seems almost impossible that a lake that is spring fed and had record high levels in early to mid summer is now so low.

We have also been receiving copies of correspondence from a landowner near the outlet that causes us great concern in what is or may be happening with the outlet. We assume the County and/or MnDNR are aware of this correspondence and is working with the landowner and/or taking appropriate action against the landowner. Who is responsible for the maintenance of the outlet? The outlet has now been sandbagged (we assume by County or MnDNR officials), but it is highly unlikely that this can be a permanent solution to the problem.

We have owned property on the lake for years and have enjoyed fishing, boating, swimming, and the beauty of the lake and do not want to see any of this compromised. The low level of the lake affects the shoreline and recreational use of the lake. We would like to know if our concerns are valid and, if so, what steps are being taken by Aitkin County and/or the MnDNR to help resolve this issue.






