PUBLIC HEALTH'S ROLE

- JANUARY 4TH: HOLDS FIRST CLINIC TO FIRST TARGET POPULATION
- JANUARY 13TH: BEGINS VACCINATING ADDITIONAL GROUPS



EXPANDED TARGET POPULATION

- JANUARY 28TH, PUBLIC HEALTH BEGINS VACCINATING SCHOOL STAFF AND CHILD CARE PROVIDERS AT AITKIN, MCGREGOR & HILL CITY CLINICS
- FEBRUARY 1ST: PUBLIC HEALTH BEGINS VACCINATING THOSE 65 AND OVER AT ADULT APARTMENTS
- RIVERWOOD BEGINS VACCINATING ONCOLOGY PATIENTS AND PATIENTS 75+

PHASE 1 B DEFINED

- MARCH 9TH: MDH FURTHER DEFINES AND ANNOUNCES PHASE 1 B EXPANSION

Phase and priority group	Populations at high risk for severe disease	Essential workers
Phase 1b – tier 2	People age 16 or 18 years and older with Sickle cell, Down Syndrome, active cancer treatment, immunocompromised from organ transplant, oxygen-dependent chronic lung or heart conditions. People with rare conditions or disabilities that put them at higher risk	Food processing facilities
Phase 1b – tier 3	People age 45-64 years with one or more underlying medical condition listed People age 16 or 18-44 years with two or more underlying medical conditions listed People age 50 years and older in multigenerational housing	Agriculture, additional school and child care workers, airport staff, correctional settings, first responders, food production, food retail (grocery), food service, judicial system workers, manufacturing, postal service workers, public transit workers, public health workers


PLANNING AHEAD FOR PHASE 1C

Phase and priority group	Populations at high risk for severe disease	Essential workers
Phase 1b – tier 4	People age 16 or 18 years and older with any underlying medical condition listed People age 50-64 years regardless of current health status.	
Phase 1c		Energy, finance, shelter/housing (construction), IT/communications, legal, media, public safety (engineers), transportation and logistics, water and wastewater.
