Summary of Issue:		
Recent discussions with representatives of the Minnesota State Highway Patrol, MnDOT District 3 Traffic Office, and Crow Wing County Highway Department have led to consensus that a speed zone study should be conducted on Tame Fish Lake Road (Aitkin CSAH 11 and Crow Wing CSAH 14) from US Hwy 169 to TH 6. Existing speed limits on this 6.5 mile highway segment are as follows from east to west: 55 mph - 45 mph - 55 mph - 50 mph - 40 mph - 30 mph. The most recent speed study on the CSAH 11 portion was conducted in 2003 and resulted in the establishment of the 45 mph zone for 1.2 miles in the vicinity of Horseshoe and Farm Island lakes.		
The speed zone study would be requested by Aitkin and Crow Wing Counties, with MnDOT District 3 Traffic Office performing the study in accordance with Minnesota Statutes and the Minnesota Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Device.

## **CSAH 11 Speed Zone Study**

WHEREAS, Aitkin CSAH 11 is part of the 6.5 mile segment of Tame Fish Lake Road from US Hwy 169 in Aitkin County to TH 6 in Crow Wing County, and

WHEREAS, a 45 mph speed zone was established by the Minnesota Department of Transportation in 2003 for a 1.2 mile segment of Aitkin CSAH 11 in the vicinity of Horseshoe and Farm Island lakes, and

**WHEREAS**, the 55 mph statutory speed limit on CSAH 11 west of this established 45 mph speed zone appears to be inconsistent with an established 50 mph speed zone on Crow Wing CSAH 14 beginning at the county line.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** That the Aitkin County Board of Commissioners requests the Minnesota Department of Transportation to perform a speed zone study on the 3.2 mile segment of Aitkin CSAH 11 from US Hwy 169 the Crow Wing County line.
