Grant applications are currently being accepted by the Minnesota Department of Transportation for eligible local projects through December 12, 2025. Applications from cities and townships are required to be sponsored by their county. ## RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR AND AGREEMENT TO SPONSOR THE CITY OF AITKIN'S PURSUIT OF 2025 LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDING FOR THE BUNKER HILL DRIVE PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, Bunker Hill Drive is a 1.0-mile Aitkin city street from State Highway 47 (4<sup>th</sup> St SE) to Aitkin County State-Aid Highway 12 (400<sup>th</sup> Ave), and

**WHEREAS,** Bunker Hill Drive provides access to Riverwood Healthcare Center (Level III Trauma Center), Elemet Manufacturing, and is a critical route for emergency service vehicles, and

**WHEREAS**, construction of a 44-unit workforce housing complex located along Bunker Hill Drive began on August 25, 2025, and the developer has also announced plans for a second 51-unit senior housing complex on Bunker Hill Drive, which, upon completion, will further increase traffic volumes and community reliance on Bunker Hill Drive for safe and efficient access, and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) administered by the Minnesota Department of Transportation provides funding up to \$1,500,000 for regionally significant projects, and

WHEREAS, the LRIP requires a city that is not a state-aid city, to obtain County Board sponsorship of the project, and

WHEREAS, the proposed year for project construction is 2027.

### NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AITKIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS; that

- 1. Aitkin County supports the City of Aitkin's pursuit of LRIP funds for the reconstruction of Bunker Hill Drive, and
- 2. Aitkin County agrees to sponsor the City of Aitkin's Local Road Improvement Program application to MnDOT and act as the city's fiscal agent for this project.
