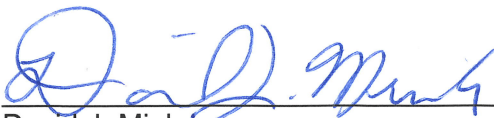

WHEREAS, the residents of Aitkin County have great respect, admiration, and the utmost gratitude for all the men and women who have selflessly served our country and this community in the Armed Forces; and

WHEREAS, the contributions and sacrifices of those who served in the Armed Forces have been vital in maintaining the freedoms and way of life enjoyed by our citizens; and

WHEREAS, Aitkin County seeks to honor individuals who have made countless sacrifices for freedom by placing themselves in harm's way for the good of all; and

WHEREAS, veterans continue to serve our community in the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, religious groups, civil service, and by functioning as County Veterans Service Officers in 29 states to help fellow former service members access more than \$52 billion in federal health, disability and compensation benefits each year; and

WHEREAS, approximately 200,000 service members transition to civilian communities annually; and an estimated 20 percent increase of service members will transition to civilian life in the near future; and

WHEREAS, studies indicate that 44-72 percent of service members experience high levels of stress during transition from military to civilian life; and

WHEREAS, active military service members transitioning from military service are at a high risk for suicide during their first year after military service; and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties encourages all counties, parishes and boroughs to recognize Operation Green Light for Veterans; and

WHEREAS, Aitkin County appreciates the sacrifices of our United States military personnel and believes specific recognition should be granted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, with designation as a Green Light for Veterans County, Aitkin County hereby declares November 4-11, 2025, as a time to salute and honor the service and sacrifices of those transitioning from active service; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in observance of Operation Green Light, for Veterans, Aitkin County will light the front of Government Services Building and the Judicial Center in green lights from November 4 – 11, 2025.

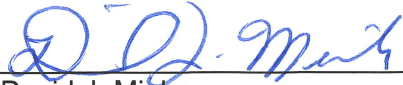

RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR AND AGREEMENT TO SPONSOR THE CITY OF AITKIN'S PURSUIT OF 2025 LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDING FOR THE BUNKER HILL DRIVE PROJECT

WHEREAS, Bunker Hill Drive is a 1.0-mile Aitkin city street from State Highway 47 (4th St SE) to Aitkin County State-Aid Highway 12 (400th Ave), and

WHEREAS, Bunker Hill Drive provides access to Riverwood Healthcare Center (Level III Trauma Center), Elmet Manufacturing, and is a critical route for emergency service vehicles, and

WHEREAS, construction of a 44-unit workforce housing complex located along Bunker Hill Drive began on August 25, 2025, and the developer has also announced plans for a second 51-unit senior housing complex on Bunker Hill Drive, which, upon completion, will further increase traffic volumes and community reliance on Bunker Hill Drive for safe and efficient access, and

WHEREAS, the Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) administered by the Minnesota Department of Transportation provides funding up to \$1,500,000 for regionally significant projects, and

WHEREAS, the LRIP requires a city that is not a state-aid city, to obtain County Board sponsorship of the project, and

WHEREAS, the proposed year for project construction is 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AITKIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS; that

1. Aitkin County supports the City of Aitkin's pursuit of LRIP funds for the reconstruction of Bunker Hill Drive, and

WHEREAS, Industrial Drive provides access to the McGregor Airport, Savanna Pallets, and is a critical route for emergency service vehicles, and

WHEREAS, the Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) administered by the Minnesota Department of Transportation provides funding up to \$1,500,000 for regionally significant projects, and

WHEREAS, the LRIP requires a city that is not a state-aid city, to obtain County Board sponsorship of the project, and

WHEREAS, the proposed year for project construction is 2026.

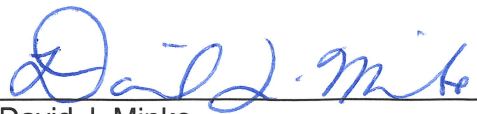
