Economic Injury Disaster Loans (EIDL) available to Aitkin County Businesses

MINNESOTA Declaration 20443 & 20444 (Disaster: MN-20004) Incident: SEVERE STORMS AND FLOODING occurring: June 16, 2024 through July 4, 2024

What Types of Disaster Loans are Available?

Business Physical Disaster Loans – Loans to businesses to repair or replace disaster-damaged property owned by the business, including real estate, inventories, supplies, machinery and equipment. Businesses of any size are eligible. Private, non-profit organizations such as charities, churches, private universities, etc., are also eligible.

Economic Injury Disaster Loans (EIDL) – Working capital loans to help small businesses, small agricultural cooperatives, small businesses engaged in aquaculture, and most private, non-profit

organizations of all sizes meet their ordinary and necessary financial obligations that cannot be met as a direct result of the disaster. These loans are intended to assist through the disaster recovery period.

Benefits of an SBA Working Capital Loan (EIDL)

- ☐ Up to \$2 million to meet ordinary and necessary financial obligations
- ☐ Low fixed interest rate with terms up to 30 years
- Automatic no payments and no interest for 12 months from the date of the first disbursement
- Apply before insurance is settled
- ☐ Unsecured up to \$25,000

REALTORS® RELIEF FOUNDATION Application for Disaster Relief Assistance

Type of Assistance

Assistance is available to qualified applicants towards one of the following options: 1) Monthly mortgage expense for the primary residence that was damaged by the Flood Disaster or; 2) Rental cost due to displacement from the primary residence resulting from the Flood Disaster or; 3) Hotel reimbursement due to displacement from the primary residence resulting from the Flood Disaster. Relief assistance is limited to a maximum of \$1,000 per household. Deadline for application submission is October 18, 2024. Please note this assistance is for housing relief only; other expenses including second mortgages (home equity lines or loans), clothing, appliances, equipment, vehicle purchase, rental or repair, and or mileage are ineligible for reimbursement under this program.

Eligibility

Recipient must be a full-time resident and U.S. citizen or legally admitted for residence in the United States.

Confidentiality

All information provided on this form will remain confidential and will be available only to those who need to confirm eligibility for assistance and to those who process the assistance to be provided. This includes providing a copy of this application to the applicant's lender or landlord, if requested. It will not be shared with other parties for any other purpose.

Disbursement of Funds

In order to provide for a reasonable and equitable distribution of funds, assistance will be provided on a first come, first serve basis. All grants are contingent upon the availability of funds


